RECRUIT PHASE

As a potential candidate for joining the Rover Crew, the Recruit Phase it is a chance for the candidate to get to know his/her potential future branch in a fun, informative and controlled way. The Rover Crew understands that the candidate may have various Troop commitments, and these come first at all times. It is up to the candidate to ensure the Crew knows these commitments. The candidate will be guided through this process by a designated sponsor assigned to them by the Crew.

SQUIRE PHASE

Should the candidate complete the Recruit Phase, and still show the desire to become a member of the Table Bay Rover Crew, they will be eligible to be invested as a Rover Squire. As a Squire they will be given a challenge to complete before being invested as a Rover and will be guided by their Sponsor.
