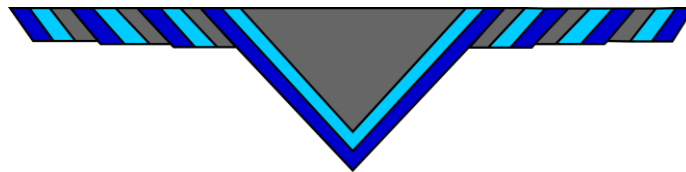




TABLE BAY ROVERS

Ways to join:

As an Adult (ages 18-30)


You are welcome to visit the Crew and join us on a few activities – you don't need to have been a Scout before to do this. If you are currently already a Scouter volunteering in a Group, that's fine too as Rovers is an 'extra' and you can do both. Contact us to learn more!

As a Scout or Ranger (age 17)


17-year-old Scouts are eligible to complete the Rover Network Badge with us – this Award involves you joining the Crew on selected activities and learning about Service

and Rovering. Scouts who complete the badge can be invested directly into the Crew when they turn 18 if they wish.
